All reports are subject to acceptance by Stuart Sailfish Club, at its discretion.

- This official Report must be used in all cases.
- Reports must be delivered to the Stuart Sailfish Club within 10 days of the date of Catch. The Stuart Sailfish Club assumes no responsibility for reports lost or delayed in the mail or by fax.
- In case of entries of exactly the same size of Catch, the time and date of Catch will determine the winner.
- Any and all Reports are accepted subject to check on the Catch by the Committee, whose opinion shall be final and binding.
- Any fish caught in violation of state, federal, or other fishing laws is ineligible. Adherence to minimum size, slot size, and/or closed season rules required. Weighing a fish not eligible for harvest is not allowed. Intentional removal of a not-harvestable fish from the water is discouraged.
- ELIGIBLE ANGLERS: Includes all SSC members EXCEPT: (a) captains, mates, or guides while working in the course of their employment, or (b) Commercial fishermen. Junior anglers who reach their 16th birthday before April 1 of the current fishing year will be considered adults for the entire year.
- The angler must fight and bring the Catch in, in a sportsmanlike manner on rod and reel, unaided. A rod broken as a result of hooking, fighting or landing a fish shall disqualify the catch.
- BOUNDARIES: Northern boundary 27°50'.00 North; southern boundary 26°46'.00 North, within U.S. territorial waters and/or maximum of 35 miles from Florida coastline.
- Mutilated fish shall not be eligible for entry. A fish that has been gutted, scaled, or deliberately mutilated before being officially weighed shall be ineligible for entry except, that a qualifying fish may be cut open by the Weigh Master for inspection.

- Fish must be weighed and/or certified by an official SSC Weigh Master, or by a USCG licensed SSC Charter Boat skipper or by any Officer or Director of the SSC.
- Official weigh stations are **Finest Kind, Pirates Cove, Sailfish Marina, Sailfish Point Marina, and Snook Nook.**
