STUART SAILFISH CLUB MEMBERS TOURNAMENT RULES & REGULATIONS

This is a one-day tournament, Saturday, November 6, with Awards Dinner held the same evening at Finest Kind Marina. This is a boat tournament, with a maximum of six anglers per boat. There must be at least two persons on board.

1. Boats of any size may fish.
2. All Boats must have VHF radio with Channel 10. No exceptions!
3. Anglers must be Club members and hold a current Florida saltwater fishing license unless exempted by State regulation.
4. Only dead bait or artificial lures may be used.
5. If natural dead bait is used, only billfish caught with a non-offset circle hook are eligible. J hook caught billfish are eligible only if the J hook was rigged with an all artificial lure.
6. IGFA rules apply except as otherwise noted in these tournament rules.
7. Maximum of two teasers and five rods may be used. Wire line is permitted.
8. Line class is unrestricted.
9. Leaders must be IGFA compliant for line class used.
10. Tournament fishing boundaries will be: N 27°50.00 (north boundary), N 26° 46.00 (south boundary) and 35 miles East of St. Lucie Inlet sea buoy.
11. Check-out begins at 7:00 am at St. Lucie Inlet sea buoy.
12. Fishing times will be from 8 am until 3:30 pm. Committee Boat will announce lines in and lines out and will be the official time keeper for the tournament.
13. All billfish releases must be called in to the Committee Boat at time of release.
14. Release is official when leader knot or swivel touches the rod tip or mate takes control of the leader.
15. All boats must check-in with the Committee Boat upon return to the St. Lucie Inlet, no later than 5:00 PM.
16. Weigh Station (Finest Kind Marina) opens at 3:30 pm and closes at 5 pm.
17. Winners in each category are determined by total points for all fish weighed or officially released.
18. Only two fish of each species per boat will be permitted to be weighed in: Wahoo, Dolphin, & Kingfish.
19. **No fish under 30" fork length will be weighed for this tournament.**

ATTENTION MEMBERS

Atlantic HMS Angling Permit (Recreational) Description
